Dollars, to be paid *one year after date hereof*

with interest thereon, from *this date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *monthly*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Property collected besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That *the said Mortgagee*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

At and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Mrs. Oling A. Peace and her Heirs*

and assigns all that certain piece of land lying and being in the State of South Carolina aforesaid, in the City of Greenville in the Second Ward of said City, bounded being Reason as Lot No. 17, as shown by plan of the Fea-gan & Moseley Larg and known as Rhode Island Creek lands having the following meter and bounded to wit:

Begunning at a stake on the west side, of Main Street and running thence with said Street S. 12-55 W. 30 feet to a stake thence N. 77-30 E. 60 feet to a stake thence S. 12-55 E. 30 feet to a stake thence S. 77-30 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner, this is the said lot of land surveyed to us by W. S. Bradley by deed recorded in the R. M. C Office for said Society and state in Vol 87 at page 95.
