in the full and just sum of Six thousand one hundred forty six and 20/100

Dollars, to be paid in ten notes of \$646.20 each one of each of the

with interest thereon, from the date of maturity at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said Trustees

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents, do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Taylor's Lumber Company

All that tract or lot of land situated, lying and being in said State and County, Chick Springs Township, on head waters of Lick Creek, branch waters of Enoree River, on the West side of the public road leading from Taylors to Tigerville adjoining lands of J. L. Cannada and others, having been deeded to the Trustees of the said St. Mark M. E. Church under date of Nov. 20th, 1877, being recorded in Vol. II at page 344, having the following metes and bounds, viz: Beginning on a small Black Oak and running thence N. 58-1/2 W. 12.10 chains to a stake; thence S. 15 W. 9.67 chains to a Pine stump; thence S. 27 E. 13.60 chains to twin pin; thence N. 23-1/2 E. 15.20 chains to the beginning corner, containing Fourteen and one-tenth acres, more or less.
