with interest thereon, from *Sept 1st 1919* at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid *Sept 1st 1920*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose his mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

*Costs of collection* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same to be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or of said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note  
reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

*Committee for John C. Sinkins* at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said *Virginia Sinkins, Committee*

*for John C. Sinkins:*  
I that certain lot of land in the city of Greenville  
being lot No. 6 of the property of Fred W. Symmes,  
having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on Lloyd street  
joining corner lots 5 and 6; thence with Lloyd  
street S. 55-40 W. 50 ft. to corner lot No. 7; thence  
with line of lot No. 7 N. 47-10 W. 185 feet 6 inches  
to iron pin; thence N. 54-15 E. 50 feet to corner  
lot No. 5; thence S. 37-10 E. 185 feet 3 inches to  
point of beginning on Lloyd street.
