computed and paid.

and paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest bear any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ~~free~~ ^{free} costs

bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. M. Verdin*

All that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate on
the south side of the Laurens Road, four miles from
Greenville Court House and having the following
metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron
pin in center of the Laurens Road, *J. Franklin Smith's*
corner, and running thence with the Laurens road
S. 31-30 E. 487 feet to a spike in center of said
road, thence continuing along the center of the
road S. 29-57 E. 290.4 feet to spike, center of said
road James Kelletts corner, thence S. 69-45 W. 19.3
feet to iron pin on side of said Laurens Road
thence S. 69-40 W. 610.5 feet along James Kelletts line, to iron
pin and stone; thence S. 68-06 W. 414.0 feet along Sullivan's
line to stone and iron pin, corner of Sullivan's
and Michael Berger; thence along Michael's Berger's line
N. 7-12 E. 397 feet to iron pin, *J. Franklin Smith's* corner
thence along *J. Franklin Smith's* line N. 47-43 E. 652.3 feet to iron
pin at edge of the Laurens Road; thence N. 47-43 E.
