Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of West Washington Street 726 1/2 feet West of Westfield Street, being the corner of the lot formerly owned by Mrs. L.L. Meredith and running thence with the line of said lot S. 28-15 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence in a straight line N. 15-45 W. 50 feet to an iron pin in Dean and Hobbs line; thence N. 28-15 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the south side of West Washington Street; thence with said West Washington Street S. 57-45 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
