a point five hundred seventy-two feet from the inter-
section of Augusta and Curson Streets and running
thence in a northerly direction 173.8 feet to a line
on the Yeager property; thence with said line in a
north easterly direction 77.1 feet; thence in a southerly
direction 167 feet to a point on Curson Street; thence
with Curson Street 60 feet to the beginning point.
