SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *Olie Pritchett*, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, *our*, am well and truly indebted to

Della Temples, in the full and just sum of Four hundred & *400.00* Dollars, to be paid One year from date

with interest thereon, from date of note at the rate of five per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

five per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the said *Olie Pritchett*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, the said

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said *Olie Pritchett* to *Della Temples*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said *Della Temples, her heirs and assigns forever: All that certain piece parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in said State of South Carolina, County of Greenville Cleveland Township about one mile north of Marietta, having the following metes and bounds according to Plat thereof prepared by William A. Hudson, dated June 28, 1906, and herewith delivered to evit:*

*Beginning at a stone near the road, a creek runs up North Saluda River to Limestone, and running thence S. 9 $\frac{3}{4}$  E. along line of land of estate of B. P. Cantrell 18.30 chains to a stone, thence N. 85 $\frac{3}{4}$  E. along line of Mrs. Lizzie M. Cleveland's land 19.60 chains (crossing the Greenville and Knoxville Railroad) to a stone on a branch, thence up said branch, following the meanders thereof as the line, about N. 14 $\frac{3}{4}$  W. 7.00 chains to a dead oak near a spring, thence N.  $\frac{1}{2}$  E. along line of land of F. Barnes and Hart, 8.50 chains to a stone, thence S. 63 $\frac{3}{4}$  W. along line of land of estate of B. P. Cantrell (crossing the Greenville and Knoxville Railroad) 20.00 chains to the beginning corner containing (30 $\frac{3}{4}$ ) acres Thirty and three-quarter acres, more or less.*
