WHEREAS, I, the said *M. Annie E. Cooper*, in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to *M. C. Meadore*.

in the full and just sum of *Five Hundred and Forty Dollars*, to be paid *January 1, 1926*.

with interest thereon, from *date mentioned above*, at the rate of *5* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *annually*.

..... until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten percent of amount due*.

..... besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
