WHEREAS, I, the said *S. G. T. J. Giles*, in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, *one*, well and truly indebted to *J. H. Rush*,

in the full and just sum of *Thirty-five hundred (\$3500.00)*,

Dollars, to be paid *one year after date*.

with interest thereon, from *Date*, at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *semi-annually*.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent.*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which are secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as in full and more fully appear).

NOW, KNOWN ALL MEN, That I, the said *S. G. T. J. Giles*, in consideration of the said sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *J. H. Rush*,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said *S. G. T. J. Giles*,

J. Giles of witness, and well and truly paid by the said *J. H. Rush*.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. H. Rush*,

all those pieces, parcels or lots land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina known and designated as late Nos. 119-120, and 121 on Plat No. 3 of Brandon Subdivision, which is recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book 6 page 130, having the following meter and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of the Easley Bridge Road, joint corner of late 118 and 119, and running thence with said joint line of said late N. 29-51 W. 30 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 42-25 W. 22 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 41-40 W. 22 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 40-55 W. 28.5 feet to an iron pin on Easley Bridge Road; thence with said Road N. 61-09 E. 66 feet to beginning point.
