besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear).

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said H. P. Mc Gee, his heirs and assigns: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the city of Greenville, in Ward One, and in the county and state aforesaid, fronting on Buckner Alley and having the following metes and bounds. Beginning at a stake on said alley at corner of Millie Thompson's lot, and running in an easterly direction along said alley forty-five (45) feet to lot now or formerly of W. H. Drivie; thence in a southerly direction ninety (90) feet to lot now or formerly of Baldwin; thence in a westerly direction Forty-five (45) feet to lot of Millie Thompson; thence in a northerly direction along her line ninety (90) feet to the beginning point on said Buckner Alley, and is the same lot conveyed to me by S. P. Hackston by deed dated May 1st, 1915.

The notes and mortgage securing these, one to said H. P. Mc Gee for One hundred (\$100.00) dollars, mortgage recorded in Vol. 106 page 46, one for three hundred (\$300.00) dollars to A. C. Wilkinson assigned to H. P. Mc Gee, recorded in volume 49, page 22, R. M. C. office for Greenville said county and state, are to be held as collateral security for this mortgage by said H. P.
