That I, B. W. Johnson,

of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, B. W. Johnson, the said
 in and by me certain note or obligation, bearing the day of August 1925,
 indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate

 Dollars, ^(76.50) Dollars,
 being the regular monthly installment payable on the ^{21st} day of Stock, and 4.33
 Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of 32.97
 Dollars, ^(21.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock, and ^(10.47) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due;
 for the next twenty months the sum of 30.10
 Dollars, ^(21.50) Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and ^(8.60) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due;
 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of 27.23
 Dollars, ^(21.50) Dollars, being the monthly payment on shares of stock and ^(5.73) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due;
 sum of 24.37
 monthly payment on shares of stock and ^(2.87) Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)
