WITNESSETH, Whereas, the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of

\$1,000.00 Dollars, money loaned this day with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight

per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows:

AT In Greenville Township, in Rock Hill District, in the County of Greenville, S. C.
Whitsett street, in Bangalore Addition, and having the
following metes and bounds: Beginning at a
stake on Pettigree street at corner of lot heretofore
sold by J. G. Bass to Bruce Moran and running
thence with Moran line N. 12-40 W. 104.5 feet
to stake on Whitsett street, thence with Whitsett
street N. 96-10 E. 117.16 feet to stake at the intersection
of Whitsett and Pettigree streets, and thence with
Pettigree street on a course ten' feet back from
face of road to the beginning corner being the
same conveyed by Orapha E. Farmer his & co. Bass
by deed dated September 20th 1923, recorded
in Book 82, page 227.
