Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Hampton Avenue, said point being 288.5 feet west from Lloyd Street, and running thence S. 41-30 W. 197 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 40-30 W. 83 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 40-40 E. 205 feet to an iron pin on the South side of said Hampton Avenue; thence along the South side of said Hampton Avenue S. 41-0 E. 84-26 feet to the point of beginning.
