until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interest to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A. D. L. Barksdale,

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and being known and designated as lot no. 63 of the Perry property as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book F at page 127, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Clayton Street, forty corner of Lots nos. 62 and 63, and running thence N. 31° 30' W. 16-0 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 58-30 W. 5-0 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 31-30 E. 15-0 feet to an iron pin on Clayton Street; thence N. 38-30 E. along said Clayton Street, 5-0 feet to the point of beginning; being the same lot of land surveyed to me by deed of Nellie E. McMillan, recorded in Volume 143, at page 165.

Also all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the Township of Paris, according to a record of survey made by W. W. Walker, in Plat Book F, page 127:-

Beginning on Paris Mountain Road, corner of Lot no. 61; thence with said road N. 3-17 W. 8-3. 6- feet to corner of Lot no. 61; thence S. 58-30 E. 23-0 feet; thence N. 31-30 E. 7-0 feet to corner of Lot no. 61; thence N. 38-30 E. 19-0 feet to the beginning of former, and thence the same lot corner, one by deed of W. W. Walker, in Plat Book F, page 127:-
