Dollars, to be paid, in the amount and on the dates as follows: *Fifty (\$50.00) appears on October 1st 1928, \$50.00* ~~and~~ *departs on the first day of each month thereafter, the final payment being payable on May 1st 1929* with interest thereon from *dated* at the rate of *6 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid monthly beginning on the first day of October, 1928*, until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal, and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interest to place, and the holder should place, the said note, or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.
