Swannell, do hereby acknowledge that I have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The First National Bank of Greenville, S. C., all my right, title and interest in and to a certain lot of land in Greenville Township, South Carolina, being designated as lot no. 10 of Block "G" of the said Utopian Developing Company as per Plat of said property made by L. M. Farman, Jr. L. E. June, 1926, and not recorded, said lot is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron Pin on North Main Street extension, joint corner of lots 10 and 11 and running thence N. 69-45 E. 197.3 feet to an iron Pin on a 15 foot alley; corner of lots 10 and 11; thence along line of said alley S. 20-15 W. 100 feet to an iron Pin, corner of lots 9 and 10; thence S. 69-45 E. 197.3 feet to an iron Pin on North Main Street, extension, joint corner lots 9 and 10; thence N. 20-15 E. along the western side of North Main Street extension 100 feet to the beginning.
