Dollars (\$4,220.00) together with the interest that shall become due upon the decreasing amounts thereof as specified, shall have been fully paid, interest being payable on the first days of July and December of each year, according to the terms of the coupon notes attached and numbered from 1 to 10 inclusive, it being provided in said note that in addition to the compulsory reduction of said principal debt by payments as above provided, the maker may pay the further sum of Four hundred dollars.
