Fowler, and are payable to the order of Southern Bond and Mortgage Company, Inc., at the office of said company, Richmond, Virginia, in gold coin of the United States of America of present standard of weight and fineness; and it is agreed that if any of said notes are not paid on the maturity dates named therein the said note or notes so unpaid shall bear interest after maturity at the rate of eight per centum per annum.
