computed and paid Annually.

.....until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent.

.....besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note..., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note....., reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said The People's Bank of Fountain Inn, S.C. a cooperation,
its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and
being on the west side of Lavinia Avenue, and the East side
of Glouer street, in the city of Greenville, County and state aforesaid.
Beginning on Lavinia Avenue at joint corner of lots 18 and
19 and running thence N. 21° 45' W. 60 feet with Lavinia Avenue
to joint corner of lots 19 and 20; thence along line of lots 19 and
20, N. 76° 30' W. 180 feet to an iron rail on Glouer street; joint corner
of lots nos. 19 and 20; thence along Glouer Street 21.45 E. 60
feet to state, joint corner of lots 18 and 19; thence along line
of lots 18 and 19, N. 76° 30' E. 180 feet to the beginning corner,
and being known and designated as lot no 19 according
to a plat made by W. A. Adams, Surveyor, in Jan'y, 1910, and
