WHEREAS, *John Edward Parkins*, the said, in and by certain financial institution, *The Bank of Greenville*, at P. O. Parkins of Greenville, South Carolina, on the even date with these presents, is well and truly indebted to *The Bank of Greenville*, in the full and just sum of *Eight thousand Thirteen Dollars and 53/100*, Dollars, to be paid.

with interest thereon, from *January 1st 1926* at the rate of *5* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *quarterly*.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Two feet court* *plus costs* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note..... reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *John Edward Parkins*, the said, in consideration of the said demand sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *mortgagee*,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *the Bank of Greenville*, the said,

in hand well and truly paid by the said *The Bank of Greenville*, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *The Bank of Greenville*, its successors and assigns, all of that lot of land situated on the North side of Elkins Street, in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on Elkins Street 87 feet from Augusta street at the North east corner of said Elkins street and an 8 foot alley and runs thence along Elkins Street E. 79. 25 & S. 45. 30 feet; thence N. 13. 25 & E. 102. 2 feet; thence N. 75. 15 W. 69 feet to an 8 foot alley; thence along the East side of said alley S. 1. 00 & N. 108. 9 to the beginning corner, being composed of three parcels of land, two of which were bounded to the by J. B. E. Grier and the other by E. Swanson, Master, and the foregoing description in accordance with plat of said land as made by C. M. Swanson, Jr. 1926.
