TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Charles Griffith, Jr.,

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Charles Griffith, Jr., in and by my certain promise, even date with these presents,

to A. P. Jordan of Greenville, S. C., in the full and just sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars, to be paid at fall-wal \$3,333.33 one year after date, \$3,333.33 five years after date and \$3,333.34 three years after date,

with interest thereon, from Date, at the rate of Six per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent. besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That, the said Charles Griffith, Jr., in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing payment thereof to the said A. P. Jordan, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of further sum of Three Dollars, to be paid to me, the said Charles Griffith, Jr., in hand well and truly paid by the said A. P. Jordan,

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said A. P. Jordan,

All that certain pieces parcels or lots of lands in Greenville, Greenville County and State, aforesaid, in Ward of the City of Greenville on the east sides of South Main Street and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on South Main Street 50 feet beyond the northeast corner of Main and Murphy Streets and running thence with said Main Street, N. 30° 30' E. 100 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 69° 30' E. 100 feet to an iron pin on line of lot formerly belonging to D. S. Harrelson then with said line S. 20° 30' W. 31 feet, thence to an iron pin, corner of lot no. 2, thence with line of lot no. 2, N. 69° 30' E. 100 feet to the beginning corner and being known and designated as lot no. 3 as shown on plat made by W. D. Meeks January 13, 1914.

Together with all my rights, title and interest in the party walls situated at the Northern side of said lot and all my rights, title and interest in the party walls situated at the Southern side of said lot and also all my rights, title and interest in the ten foot alley situated on the rear of said lot.

The above described lot being the same conveyed to me by Sam R. Zimmerman and Herbert Lindsey by deed dated November 16th 1923 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in vol. 90 page 255.

It is understood that this mortgage constitutes a lien junior to other liens of a mortgage heretofore executed by me to the United States Mortgage and Trust Company for the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars.
