Office for Greenville County. Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Overbrook Road, 11-60 and road, running thence N. 80-20 E. 59 feet along back side of Overbrook Road to an iron pin, the first corner of lot 20-60 and 59, thence S. 5-53 E. 181.4 feet along front line of lot 20-60 and 59 to an iron pin, thence S. 89-35 W. 128 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Overbrook Circle, thence along east side of Overbrook Circle 26.16-24 E. 35.6 feet, thence N. 11-32 E. 34.6 feet, N. 14-37 E. 54 feet, N. 12-57 E. 55.3 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Overbrook Circle, thence N. 52-17 E. 7 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Overbrook Road to point of beginning.
