WHEREAS, we, the said R. L. Wofford and T. M. Wofford, in and by certain note, in writing, of even date with these presents,

in the full and just sum of \$150.00 hundred Dollars,

Dollars, to be paid Feb. 5, 1927,

with interest thereon, from Feb. 5, 1927, at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid at maturity,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof. If the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had), as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN THAT, the said R. L. Wofford and T. M. Wofford, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said W. J. McLean,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to the said W. J. McLean,

in hand well and truly paid by the said W. J. McLean,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. J. McLean, all that certain tract of

land, lying, situated, bounded, described, and marked out in the State of South Carolina, and being one of the tracts of land so called and described to R. L. Wofford by deed dated Feb. 5, 1919 and record filed in the Register Office in the County of Spartanburg, State of South Carolina, page 112, and more particularly described as follows, beginning at a pine tree in the middle of a small branch of the creek running westwardly, thence west 17 chains 50 links to W. L. Wofford's corner, from W. L. Wofford's corner run north along the creek 17 chains 50 links to a branch thence down said branch to the creek. Thence follow said creek to a stone on N. W. Wofford's land, with sand line N. 80 W. 9.60 chs. to stone on N. W. Wofford's land in Stewart's line, thence with Stewart's line N. 10 W. 7.22 to the beginning corner containing fifty two (52) acres more or less.

Also all that certain tract in said Township, County and State beginning at a stone on N. W. Wofford's corner in Stewart's line, running with his line S. 10 E. 31.13 links to a stone at the right angle N. 72 E. 15.6 chs. to stone set at chestnut, thence N. 2 E. 34 W. 7.46 to Red Oak on Public road, thence west said road and crossing creek N. 42 E. 8.18.85 to pine thence N. 1/2 E. 14.24 links to stone on N. W. Wofford's corner, thence to crossing the creek N. 83 W. 22.32 to the beginning corner containing fifty two (52) acres more or less. Also all that lot or parcel of land, lying and situate in the town of Sparta, Spartanburg County, State of South Carolina, bounded, the two lots conveyed to W. S. Calvert by J. E. Barnes by deed of Oct. 14, 1914 containing one acre, more or less, beginning at an iron pin in street right of way running S. W. with land formerly owned by Duncan 2.95 chains to iron pin thence west with line of Green Howards said 3.36 chs. to iron pin thence south with E. L. Tucker's line 2.95 chs. to iron pin in street thence with street 3.30 chs. to the beginning.
