Dollars, to be paid in six annual payments as follows: \$300.00 payable Jan. 4th 1927,  
\$200.00 payable Jan. 4th 1928; \$300.00 payable Jan. 4th 1929; \$300.00  
payable Jan. 4th 1930; \$200.00 payable June 4th 1931; \$350.00  
payable Jan. 4th 1932.

with interest thereon, from Date 1928 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid annually.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent.*

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said C. O. Bayne  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money, aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said.

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said.

C. O. Bayne, in hand well and truly paid by the said J. K. Tuff

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said J. K. Tuff his heirs and assigns forever,

that certain tract of land lying and being  
situated in State and County aforesaid, Grove Town-  
ship, and where the same is described as follows:

Begins along a branch; thence S. 39 1/2 W. 11.50 to iron  
pin, thence S. 40 E. W. 20.50 to iron pin; thence S. 65 E. 6.40  
to iron pin; thence N. 72 E. 25.50 to iron pin; thence N.  
6.05 to stone or iron pin; thence N. 73 E. 11.78 to branch;  
thence S. 45 E. with the meanderings of branch to the  
regular corner containing twenty-three (23) acres  
more or less, and bounded by lands of Ben Evans,  
P. F. McCombe and Malcolm Meadows and others.

This being the same tract of land conveyed to  
me by Ben Evans by his deed bearing date of  
March 4th 1926, and formerly conveyed to Ben  
Evans by J. K. Tuff by his deed bearing date
