Dollars, to be paid One (1) year after date, 33

Interest to be paid monthly from date of note  
with interest thereon, from date of note,  
computed and paid at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be  
paid monthly in advance

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Twenty-five cents (10¢) on the amount due, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said J. K. Powers, Attorney his heirs and

assigns, All that piece parcel or tract of land  
in Greenville Township County and State aforesaid  
about one and one half (1 1/2) miles south of Greenville  
Court House and having the following lines and  
bounds to wit: Beginning in center of party (40)  
foot road thence S. 45° E. 2.40 Chains to Stairnes  
corner, thence with Dayries line, S. 42° W. 90' thence  
S. 31 1/4 E. 2.30 to Fichiers line, thence S. 28 1/4 E. 9';  
thence N. 45 1/2 E. 2.30 to branch tree with branch  
Pine heart 8.20, thence S. 60 1/2 W. 9.70 to aerry tree  
thence N. 45 1/2 W. 19.75, thence N. 61 E. 6.10 to road.  
thence N. 46 3/4 W. 9.25 to beginning corner and
