WHEREAS, I, D. E. Linchberger,

SEND GREETING:

in and by my certain Prossessory note in writing, of even date with these presents, Am' well and truly indebted to.

Farmers Loan & Trust Company as Trustee for Mrs. Rosa B. Irving, in the full and just sum of Twenty five hundred (\$2500.00) Dollars, to be paid.

with interest thereon, from. computed and paid. Semi Annually at the rate of 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. per annum, to be

paid until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten (10%) percent

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, the said D. E. Linchberger,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Farmers Loan & Trust Company, as Trustee as aforesaid,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

D. E. Linchberger,

in hand well and truly paid by the said Farmers Loan & Trust Company as Trustee as aforesaid,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Farmers Loan & Trust Company, as Trustee as aforesaid,

as aforesaid, First, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on the extension of Hampton Avenue beyond the overhead bridge, and having a frontage on said extension of Hampton Avenue of fifty (50) feet with a depth in parallel lines of one hundred fifty (150) feet.

Second, also all that other certain piece parcel or lot of land adjoining the above lot situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on St. Clair Street or Hampton Avenue Extension and described as follows to wit. Beginning at the corner of the above described lot, and running thence with St. Clair Street on Hampton Avenue Extension twenty (20) feet to the lot of land owned by H. C. Reese, thence with the line of Reese lot 68.6 feet to line of the above described lot, thence with the line of said lot N. 18 E. 24.6 feet, more or less to the beginning corner.

Third, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, adjoining the above described lot situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on the Southern side of Hampton Avenue Extension, and described as follows to wit.

Beginning at the corner of a lot now owned by the mortgagor herein and running thence in a Northwesterly direction 49 feet 1/2 inches to an iron pin thence in a South Westerly direction 150 feet to an iron pin, thence in a Northeasternly direction 49 feet 1/2 inches to corner of lot now or formerly owned by E. O. Couch thence with the line of said lot in a North Easterly direction 150 feet to the beginning corner.

The lots hereinabove described are the same lots of land conveyed by E. O. Couch (same as E. O. T. Couch) to me by deed dated March 6, 1924 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County S. C. in Volume 102, page 65.
