Forty Dollars or on or by April 10th 1930 and in the further sum of
One hundred and One dollars in and by a note of even date, due April
10th 1932
 with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum, to be
 computed and paid *Annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *10 per cent.*
