at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said Green Bank & Trust Company:

All that piece, parcel, or tract of land situate, lying and being
in the County and State aforesaid in Real Township, lying
on both sides of Frohawk Creek being generally known as
the Rector Place, and is the same tract of land Conveyed
to me by J. V. Vaughn, in deed recorded in the P. M. C.
Office for Greenville County in Book "555", at page 469;
Containing Fifty-seven acres, more or less.

Also all that other tract of land, situate, lying and being
in the County and State aforesaid, known as Lot #4 of
the Crockett land, containing Forty-six and three-fourths
acres ($46\frac{3}{4}$), more or less; and is part of the tract of
land Conveyed to me by J. V. Vaughn in the above men-
tioned deed.
