Beginning on a Point at the Southwest intersection of Melville Street and Augusta Road, and running thence along the South side of said Augusta Road, S. $46^{\circ} 30'$ E. 113.2 feet to the joint corner of Lots nos. 3 and 4; thence along the joint line of lots nos. 3 and 4 S. $21^{\circ} 41'$ W. 425.4 feet to a Point in the rear line of Lot no. 4; thence along the rear line of lot no. 4 N. $46^{\circ} 30'$ W. 81 feet to a Point in the edge of Melville Street; thence along the Eastern side of said Melville Street, N. $17^{\circ} 47'$ E. 438 feet to the Point of beginning.
