america all that certain lot of land, with improvements thereon, situate in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina on the Eastern side of South Laurens Street, in the block between St. M'Bea Ave. and West Washington Streets, and having, according to a plat thereof prepared by J. C. M. Turnip Jr. Engineer, October 23rd 1929, the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at a point on the Eastern side of South Laurens Street, 142 feet, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches North of the northeasterly intersection of West M'Bea Avenue and South Laurens Street, which iron pin is in the center of a brick wall, and running thence along the Eastern side of South Laurens Street, N. 18° 15' E. 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet 2 inches to an iron pin in the center of a brick wall, thence along the center of said brick wall, S. 71° 00' E. 102 feet 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches to an iron pin, thence S. 18° 15' 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet, 7 inches to an iron pin; thence S. 71° 00' E. 12 feet, 1 inch to an iron pin; thence S. 18° 15' 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet, 5 inches to an iron pin; thence N. 71° 00' 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet, 10 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches (said line passes through the center of the brick wall first above mentioned), to the point of beginning.
