SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I the said J. H. Henderson and The Prudential Insurance Company of America  
in and by one certain Note or obligation bearing even date herewith, stand indebted unto

in the full and just principal sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,500.00),  
to be paid in five years from date, at the dates and in the amounts as follows, namely:

12 1. 00 on the first day of January, 1936  
12 1. going to the second day of January, 1937  
12 1. 00 on the third day of January, 1938  
12 1. 00 on the fourth day of January, 1939

The debt shall pass to the fifth day of January, 1940  
has been paid to the third day of January, 1939  
the same is paid to the fifth day of January, 1940

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and with interest from date at the rate of five and one-half per cent. per annum, payable annually on the first day of December for each year, past due principal and interest to bear interest at the rate of seven per cent. per annum, as reference being had to said note will more fully appear; default in any payment of either principal or interest to render the whole debt due at the option of the Mortgagor.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN that I the said J. H. Henderson in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Prudential Insurance Company of America, Newark, New Jersey

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS, to me the said J. H. Henderson

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Prudential Insurance Company of America at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Prudential Insurance Company of America the following described real estate, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying and situate in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located on public road from Fountain Inn to Felgate about seven miles west from Fountain Inn, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point marking the Northeasterne corner of the within described tract, which point marks corner with the lands now or formerly owned by A. H. Broshier and which point is in center of the Jenkins Bridge Road; thence along the center of said road as the same meanders, South 84 degrees West 31 chains to a stone, thence leaving said road South 23 3/4 degrees East 3.00 chains to a stone; thence South 25 3/4 degrees East 8.06 chains to a stone; thence South 33 degrees East 3.00 chains to a stone; thence South 38 1/4 degrees East 7.14 chains to a stone; thence South 43 3/4 degrees East 14.30 chains to a stone; thence South 37 degrees East 1.95 chains to a stone; thence South 45 3/4 degrees East 5.56 chains to a stone; thence North 78 degrees East 10 chains to a stone, the end of a branch; thence along the center of said branch as the same meanders in a general NNE direction 33 chains more or less to a stone, marking corner with said A. H. Broshier's lands; thence leaving said branch North 13 1/2 degrees West 9.15 chains to the point and place of beginning. Said tract contains 83 acres according to survey made by James Shalis, Surveyor, under date of February 12, 1912.

J. H. Henderson And being the son of said land as conveyed to J. H. Henderson, Jr., herein by deed dated February 12, 1912, recorded Book '34, Page 49, records of Greenville County, South Carolina.

Privilege is given to said party for the first part his heirs or legal representatives to make additional payments on the principal sum of said note on any interest-payment date, in accordance however with the terms of such privilege as set forth in said note.

And it is further agreed and covenanted between the said parties hereto that in case the debt secured by this mortgage or any part thereof is collected by suit - action and this mortgage is foreclosed,
