all that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, on the South side of East Eagle Street, and having, according to a plat thereof prepared by C. W. Fanning, Jr., Engineer, dated November 8th, 1926 the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the South side of East Eagle Street, which stake is 391 feet 6 inches East of the East side of Elizabeth Street and running thence S. 18-30 E. 206 feet 6 inches to a stake; thence S. 71-20 E. 65 feet, 5 inches to a stake; thence N. 18-30 E. 206 feet 6 inches to a stake on the South side of East Eagle Street; thence along the South side of East Eagle Street N. 71-20 W. 65 feet, 5 inches to the point of beginning and being the same lot of land Conveyed to the Mortgagor herein by Belle Woodard Snelling by deed, dated July 17th 1926, and recorded in the R.
