WHEREAS, *R. P. Wall*,

in the State aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

in and by *my* certain Bond or Obligation of even date herewith stand firmly held and bound unto CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, in the full sum of *Six hundred* Dollars, conditioned for the payment of the monthly sum of *12 m* Dollars, on the first Tuesday *fifth* of each and every month succeeding the date hereof, until each and every share in the said Association shall reach the value of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS, and also for *ten open credit* attorney's fees, in case of suit or of collection by or through an attorney, which, in addition to said debt, is hereby secured and made a lien on the premises as in and by the said Bond and Condition thereof, reference being therunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *R. P. Wall*,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said CITIZENS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, according to the condition of said Bond; and, also, in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS, to *one* to said *R. P. Wall*,

in kind, well and truly paid to the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, at and before the sealing and delivery of the presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,

the said *R. P. Wall*, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, all that lot of land, in said State and County, in the City of Greer, on the *side of*

ac. that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, O'neall Township, State aforesaid, on both sides of Beaverdam Creek, Beginning at a stone in the Woods, south of the New Bruce Road, W. G. Lynn and S. G. Lynn corner, and running thence N. 33° E. 1.26 chs to a stake, in the center of the New Bruce Road, thence N. 51½ E. 4.40 chs to a stake in the East edge of said road, thence N. 7½ W. 6.81 chs to a stake in the center of said road, thence N. 22° E. 2.61 chs to a Post Oak 3x, thence N. 13½ E. 2.30 chs to the center of Beaverdam Creek, at the mouth of a branch thence N. 39° W. 2.00 chs to a point in center of said creek, thence up the said creek, N. 23° E. 8.10 chs to a point in the center of the creek, thence N. 81/4 E. 15.40 chs with the Annie Edwards line to a stake in the top soil road, thence along said road S. 17½ E. 6.90 chs to a stake in the road, thence with the Bruce Line S. 43½ W. 10.64 chs to a post oak stump, thence N. 86½ W. 1.56 chs to a Sweet Gum 3x, on the East side of Beaverdam Creek, at the southeast corner of the bridge, thence S. 15 E. 1.30 chs to a Persimmon 3x, S. G. Lynn's corner, thence S. 41/2 W. 17.65 chs with S. G. Lynn's line to the beginning, containing 27.7 acres more or less, according to a survey and plat made by W. A.
