the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to make:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and for further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

*Land described: Lot No. 12, the Deed of R. E. Deacon, dated May 12, 1926, M.S.*  
and place, with the same description, vizt the said Mechanics Hall on Laurel Street and being and designated as lot No. 12, and part of property of lot No. 3, made by R. E. Deacon, engineer April 1926, and having according to said plat the following courses and distances - Beginning at a point on Laurel Street corner of property of E. Dewey, Owner and American Spinning Company and running thence along property of American Spinning Company S. 33.54 W. 178.7 feet to Bates St.; thence along Bates Street S. 20-34 E. 50 feet to corner of lot No. 2; thence along line of lot No. 2 N. 33.54 E 178.5 feet to Laurel Street; thence along Laurel Street N. 55.54 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
