the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the state aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying
and being in the State and County aforesaid, and
in Ward 1 of the City of Greenville, containing Forty-four
(44) feet on Hampton Avenue, and has the
following lines and bounds to-wit: Beginning at
an iron pin 3x on Hampton Avenue 69 feet
southeast from the 3x of said Hampton Avenue
and Echoe Street, and runs thence with J. F.
Simpson's line N. 52. 3° E. eighty-four (84) feet
to an iron pin, the 3x of Brown's lot; thence
N. 41-15 W. Forty-two (42) feet to an iron pin 3x;
thence S. 56-30 W. eighty-four and eight tenths
(84.8) feet to an iron pin 3x on north side of
Hampton Avenue; thence with said Hampton
Avenue S. 44 E. Forty-four (44) feet to the be-
ginning 3x, and is bounded by lands of J. F.
Simpson, E. C. Brown and Stephen King and
Hampton Avenue, being the same lot of land con-
veyed to me by Stephen King on March 4, 1913,
and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville
County in Volume 18, page 180.
