THIS INDENTURE, made this 1st day of February A. D. 1927

by and between A. Lueger Fauston

party of the first part, and the MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, of Greenville, S. C., a corporation, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH, Whereas the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of Thirty three hundred (\$3300.00)

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released unto by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

~~all that piece of land situate, lying and
being in this County and State aforesaid, just outside
the corporate limits of the city of Greenville, S. C. and
being the Southern portion of lot no 149 (fronting
33 feet on the East side of Redwood Drive
and running back in parallel lines 17 3 feet to
the rear line of said lot), and 17 feet off the
Northern portion of Lot No. 148, fronting 67 feet
on East side of Redwood Drive, and running
back in parallel lines 14 3 feet to rear line
of said lot) said lot being described as a
single tract as follows: Beginning at an iron
pin on the East line of Redwood Drive, said
place of beginning being 17 feet from Northwest
corner of lot No. 149, according to Plat No. 3
of Overbrook Land Company and Woodville
Investment Company, being recorded in Plat
Book "F", page 2187, R. M. G. office for Greenville
County reference to which plat is hereby made
as a part of this description, and running
thence N. 83° 32' E. along a line parallel to the
Northern line of Lot No. 149 14 3 feet to an
iron pin on the Eastern line of said lot
thence N. 6° 28' E. along the Eastern line of said
lot No. 149 and of lot No. 148 50 feet to an iron
pin on the Eastern line of lot No. 148, thence S.
8° 32' W. along line parallel to Northern line of
said lot No. 148 14 3 feet to an iron pin on
Eastern line of Redwood Drive; thence N. 6° 28'
W. along said Eastern line of Redwood Drive 50
feet to point of beginning. This being the same lot
of land conveyed to me by J. D. Poteat by his deed
dated July 19, 1926 recorded Volume 117, page 243 except
1 foot conveyed by me from the Northern edge
thereof to Ella J. McPhee.~~

As additional security to this loan I have this
day transferred and assigned unto the said
Mechanics Building and Loan Association a certain
note and mortgage dated June 3rd 1926, given
by Ellie Walden and Francis S. Skinner to
J. D. Poteat as trustee, in the sum of \$800.00
providing for 6% interest payable semi annually
the said note and mortgage having been
fully transferred and assigned to the J. D.
Poteat as trustee and the mortgage being
recorded in the R. M. G. office of Greenville
County in mortgage Book 119, page 132.
