SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, the said R. J. Rowley and G. L. Foster

 in the full and just sum of Three thousand and 3⁰⁰
 Dollars, to be paid three years after date,

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be
 computed and paid annually,

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
 interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
 may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part hereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceeding of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said Miss R. A. Brown, all that certain piece
 of land or tract of land situate, lying and being in the
 State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in High-
 way Township, near Greenville, on waters of South
 Pungo River, and having such metes and bounds as are
 shown in the deed made to W. A. Hudson by Geo.
 F. Southern, dated April 29th, 1910, and recorded in
 R. M. C. office for said County and State in Volume
 #2 of Deeds, at page 140, and containing 68 acres, more
 or less. Also all that certain piece, I parcel or tract
 of land situate lying and being in the same State
 County and Township and adjoining the above tract
 and having such metes and bounds as are shown in
 a deed made to W. A. Hudson by Geo. C. Farmer,
 dated December 1, 1909, and recorded in the above
 named office in Volume 5 of Deeds, at page 147
 and containing 238 acres, more or less.
