with interest thereon, from January 1, 1926 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid January 1, 1926.

until paid in full, interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent,

beyond all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had), shall more fully appear).

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said H. B. Leatherwood,

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. B. Leatherwood,

*Attorney* all that piece, parcel or lot 10 in the Woodside Circle in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, just without the City limits of Greenville, on the Rutherford Road, and being known and described as the rear portion of lots Nos. 15, 16, 17 and 18 in Woodside Circle, a subdivision of the Woodside Circle property, according to the plat recorded in Plat Book "E", at page 219, of said lot having a frontage of fifty (50) feet on North Woodside Circle, and a depth in parallel lines of one hundred (100) feet, and adjoining lots 17 and 18.
