WHEREAS, I, the said J. W. Warkman, in and by my certain Plazierancy, even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to Farmers Loan and Trust Company of Greenville, S. C. in the full and just sum of Forty five Hundred (\$4,500.00) Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Farmers Loan and Trust Company,

Greenville, S. C. All that piece parcel or tract of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on waters of Green's Creek, waters of South Pacolet River.

Beginning on a white oak, thence to a flocked Chestnut; thence E. 85° W. 24 chs. to a Chestnut; thence S. 75° W. 7 chs. and 58 links to a Red Oak; thence S. 13° E. to a rock on line of land now or formerly owned by M. Ballou; thence S. 41° W. 15 chs. and 60 links; thence to a rock on Ridgeline line; thence S. 60° E. 22 chs. and 53 links to Chestnut stump; thence N. 50° E. 24 chs. 50 links to a small Post Oak; thence running with line of land now or formerly owned by Sidney Butler, to a Chestnut; thence S. 5d E. 7 chs. to a White Oak; thence N. 16° E. 12 chs. to a Red oak; thence N. 13° E. 11 chs. and 66 links to Chestnut; thence N. 10° E. 12 chs. and 84 links to the beginning corner, containing 175 acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land, conveyed to me by Rosa Farmer by deed of even date herewith, the same not yet recorded.
