WHEREAS, B. S. Borroughs, the said B. S. Borroughs,

computed and paid 1921 July 1st 1921

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 15% less expenses

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be
added to the amount due on said note....., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note....., reference
being thereto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said B. S. Borroughs,

all that certain piece of land situate, lying and being
in the City and District of Greenville State of South Carolina,
in the sixth Ward of Arlington Avenue and being more particularly
described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the south side
of said Arlington Avenue, at the corner of lot 14, and running
by W. H. Wood to Emma L. Butler's residence, thence
page 312, which point is 93 feet west of east from the East
side of Madison Street and running thence with said Madison
Avenue and Easterly direction 52 1/2 feet to a stake at the corner
of Roberto Mow or formerly owned by W. T. Norton, thence
with that line in a southerly direction 68 1/2 feet to a stake, thence
in a westerly direction 59.4 feet to a stake on corner of said lot
conveyed by W. T. Wood to Emma L. Butler, thence with line in a
