the said Miss Psyche Webster, the said lot No. 16 in the Melrose subdivision in Greenville County, South Carolina, being a part of the lands of said Company known as "Melrose", said lot being known and designated on a plat of said lands made by Carter & Bringle, Surveyors (which plat is recorded in said office) as lot No. 16 of Block "H" fronting 50 feet each on Tremont Street and running back 140 feet to an alley, facing 50 feet each on the alley, and further specifications as shown on a plat of the Melrose subdivision which is recorded in Plat Book in R.
