until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *100 dollars* and *and Cancellation of Note* besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceeding of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear).

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. A. Baling* all that certain piece, parcel or

lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the city of Greenville and being a part of what is known as City View Land Co. plat of which is recorded in plat book A, at page 54, lot 461, and being known and designated as lot no. 54 in Block A, on said plat and having a frontage of 50 ft on each side of Henderson St. and running back in parallel lines 150 feet and being the lot conveyed by J. C. Howard & T. M. Locke and Da Locke by deed dated Feb. 9th, 1921 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in vol. 62, page 68.

also all that piece, parcel or strip of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about two miles west of Greenville, Court house, and being a portion of the property known as "City View" beginning at a stake "150 ft" from the North East corner of Summit St. same being on Henderson Street, joint corner of late nos. 53 and 54 and running thence S. 89 1/2 E. 150 feet to a stake, corner of late nos. 53 and 54, 4 and 5, thence S. 0. 30 W. 25 feet, to a stake, thence N. 89 1/2 E. 150 feet to a stake, on Henderson St. thence N. 0. 30 E. 25 ft to the beginning corner, and being a portion of lot no 53 according to a plat made by W. A. Adams, Surveyor, deed recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County, vol. 39, page 34, Feb. 16, 1916.

It is hereby understood by and between the parties hereto that this is given to further secure a chattel note and mortgage given by J. E. Grant, this date and for which I have given my note for a like amount for same purpose.
