forever, all that certain lot, parcel or piece of land, situate in the County of Greenville, City of Greenville and State aforesaid, on the south side of East Earle Street, at the intersection of the Chick Springs Road, being known and designated as lot #3, according to a plat of the property of Walter W. Goldsmith and Wilson G. Harvey, drawn by Dalton & Nees, dated June 1926, which Plat is a revision of lots 20, 21, and 22 of section 6, Stone Land Company property and being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of East Earle Street, and the Chick Springs Road, then continuing North 71-30 west 87.7 to an iron pin, joint corner of lot no. 2 & 3; thence South 17-41 West 146-2 to point along the Chick Springs Road, thence North 60-51 East 128 feet along Chick Spring Road to an iron pin, thence North 17-41 East 51.7 to the point of beginning.
