SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said *Alvin C. Granger*, of Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in and by my certain note, in writing, of Carolina, even date with these presents, *Dec. 1st*, well and truly indebted to *W.W. Putman*, of Greenville, S.C., in the full and just sum of *Fifteen hundred* Dollars, to be paid *one December 31st and 1927*.

with interest thereon, from *Oct. 13th, A.D. 1926*, at the rate of *6* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *at maturity*.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note, to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *10 Per cent.*

Dec. 1st, besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *W.W. Putman*, *Alvin C. Granger*, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *W.W. Putman*,

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said *Alvin C. Granger*, in hand well and truly paid by the said *W.W. Putman*.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *W.W. Putman his heirs and assigns*:

Ie that certain Piece, Parcel or lot of land, situated lying and being in the state of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, near Duncan Mill Property and being known and designated as lot no. 4 on Plat of Duncan Heights, said Plat is recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County on Plat Book D. at Page 67, said lot being on the corner of Hillhouse Street and the National Highway. For a full description by metes and bounds, see said Plat. This being the same lot of land conveyed to W.W. Putman by L.P. Hillhouse, as Trustee and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County Vol. 44, Page 242, Oct. 2nd, 1918, and to me by W.W. Putman. Also.

Also lot no. 3 of subdivision of land known as Duncan Heights Plat of which is recorded in office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book D. Page 67, and having the following metes and bounds according to said Plat; Beginning at a stake on west side of National Highway, corner of lot no. 2. N. 54-15 W. 129 feet to a stake, joint corners of lots. 2. 3. 21, 22; thence with line of lot no. 21, S. 34-15 E. 60 feet to a stake, corner of lot no. 4, thence S. 54-15 E. 138 feet to a stake on National Highway to the beginning corner. This being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W.W. Putman and the same lot of land conveyed to him by W.J. Green and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 64, Page 70, dated May 1st, 1920.
