computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said Frances G. Endel, her heirs and assigns forever, all that certain
piece, parcel or lot of land situate in the City and aforesaid at or near the corporate
limits of the City of Greenville, being the rear portion of lot No. 15, said lot number
15 being known on a plat of Mrs. H.D. Wilkins property made by R.E. Dalton, C.E., dated
March 1924 and recorded in Plat Book F, at page 209 in the office of Register of Mesne
Conveyance for Greenville County and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
Beginning at an iron pipe on Otis Street, said pipe being 110 feet from the northwest
corner of Otis Street and Elm Street and running thence along Otis Street S. 72-00 W. 60
feet; thence in a northerly direction along the rear line of lot No. 16, 63.05 feet to
an iron pipe, joint lines of lots No. 14, 15, 16 and 17 as shown on the plat above
referred to; thence N. 72 E. 60 feet to a stake on the line of lots No. 14 and 15; thence
in a straight line to an iron pipe on Otis Street, the same being the corner of
beginning. This lot being the same conveyed unto R.S. Faris by E.W. Altom on January 16,
