Williams, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot land situated, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, bounded at the front of the said road corner of said lands belonging to J. B. Henderson and wife Howell, thence along the side of said road and corner of 48-40 W. 2-44 feet to a stone corner continuing in line of said property 50-5 feet to a stone post to a iron pin, in the said property, thence along said property N. 31-15 W. 135 feet to a large Maple on the bank of a branch, thence down the meadowings of said branch to an iron pin at the mouth of another branch, a traverse line being as follows, S. 61-15 W. 95.5 feet to a bend, S. 61-0 W. 500 feet to a bend, S. 0-24 E. 95 feet to said iron pin, thence a branch along property of Jack Ballinger to an iron pin on the bank of said branch, a traverse line, between said points being as follows, N. 28-49 W. 182 feet to a bend, N. 2-41 W. 300 feet to a bend, N. 6-34 W. 300 feet to a bend, N. 11-40 W. 600 feet to a bend, N. 45 E. 39 feet to said iron pin, thence N. 24-0 W. 69.3 feet to a stone in the of said Ballinger property, thence continuing along Ballinger's line N. 14-50 E. 1774 feet to a stone, thence N. 89-20 W. 1447 feet along same property to a stone, thence N. 41-20 E. 543.5 feet along property of Brodus Williams to a stone, thence along line of J.
