and agreed for the term of three years from the date of the execution of this note and agreed that I will pay the same with interest at the rate of five per cent per annum and if any portion of principal or interest is not paid when due to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage said note further providing for an attorney's fee of one hundred and thirty dollars besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection or if said debt or any part thereof be collected by any attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage as in and by the said note reference being thereunto made as will more fully appear.)
