That certain tract of land conveyed to the Company by deed from Blue Mountain Consolidated Water Company, dated July 31, 1963, and recorded in Volume 198, Page 93, of the Deed Records of Northampton County, Pennsylvania, and being described as follows: All that certain tract, piece or parcel of ground situate and being in the Township of Plainfield, County of Northampton and State of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows, to wit: DESCRIPTION OF POINT OF BEGINNING—Referenced from an angle point on the Northampton County-Monroe County Boundary Line as described by the Blue Ridge Land Company (William Gibbs & wife) tract of the Blue Mountain Consolidated Water Company property; thence along said County Boundary Line North fifty-seven degrees forty minutes East (N. 57° 40' E.) a distance of one thousand eight hundred forty-five feet, more or less, to a point, which point is South fifty-seven degrees forty minutes West (S. 57° 40' W.) a distance of eight hundred fifty-six feet, more or less, along said County Boundary Line from its intersection with the easterly property line of the said Blue Ridge Land Company (William Gibbs & wife) tract of the Blue Mountain Consolidated Water Company property; thence by right angle South thirty-four degrees twenty-three minutes thirteen seconds East (S. 34° 23' 13" E.) a distance of two hundred five feet, more or less, to the mid-point on the northwesterly property line of the herein described tract; thence along said property line South fifty-five degrees thirty-six minutes forty-seven seconds West (S. 55° 36' 47" W.) a distance of two hundred ten feet to a point, the point of beginning of the tract, which point is a stake. DESCRIPTION OF TRACT—From the Point of Beginning South thirty-four degrees twenty-three minutes thirteen seconds East (S. 34° 23' 13" E.) a distance of four hundred twenty feet to a point, which point is a stake; thence North fifty-five degrees thirty-six minutes forty-seven seconds East (N. 55° 36' 47" E.) a distance of four hundred twenty feet to a point, which point is a stake; thence North thirty-four degrees twenty-three minutes thirteen seconds East (N. 34° 23' 13" E.) a distance of four hundred twenty feet to a point, which point is a stake; thence South fifty-five degrees thirty-six minutes forty-seven seconds East (S. 55° 36' 47" E.) a distance of four hundred twenty feet to a point, the point of beginning; containing in all four and five hundredths (4.05) acres.
