Station 515, a main line valve assembly at approximate mile post 80.79, a main line valve assembly on the east side of the Susquehanna River at approximate mile post 94.51, a main line valve assembly on the west side of the Susquehanna River at approximate mile post 94.87, and a main line valve assembly at approximate mile post 103.83.

- (b) One 36-inch main line loop (line "C") section approximately 11.77 miles in length, beginning at the east end of the existing loop at approximate mile post 1679.30, located on the west bank of the Susquehanna River in Lower Chanceford Township, York County, and continuing in an easterly direction to approximate mile post 1691.06, located in Eden Township, Lancaster County, all in the State of Pennsylvania. Included in this main line loop section are a river valve with cross-over header to lines "A" and "B" on the east side of the Susquehanna River, and a main line valve assembly with double cross-over to lines "A" and "B" at approximate mile post 1691.06.
- (c) One 42-inch main line loop (line "C") section, approximately 26.36 miles in length, beginning at the east end of the existing loop at approximate mile post 1738.95, located in Whitpain Township, Montgomery County, and continuing in an easterly direction to the header assembly on the west side of the Delaware River, located in Lower Makefield Township, Bucks County, all in the State of Pennsylvania. Included in this main line loop section are a main line valve assembly with double cross-overs to lines "A" and "B" at approximate mile post 1747.93, a main line valve assembly at approximate mile post 1757.51, and a river valve assembly with cross-over to lines "A" and "B" at the Delaware River.
- (d) One 36-inch main line loop (line "C") section approximately 2.50 miles in length, beginning at approximate mile post 1691.06, located in Eden Township, and continuing to the end of the loop section at approximate mile post 1693.56, located in Bart Township, all in the County of Lancaster, State of Pennsylvania. Included in this loop section is a main line valve with double cross-overs to lines "A" and "B" at the beginning of the loop section.
