 even date with these presents, *and I* *Oscar Hodges, Attorney*
 in the full and just sum of *Thirteen Thousand (\$1,300.00)*
 Dollars, to be paid *one year after date*

with interest thereon, from *date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be
 computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal
 or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
 may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent*

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be
 added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
 part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being
 thereunto had, as will more fully appear).

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
 bargain, sell and release unto the said *Oscar Hodges, Attorney*,

all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate in
Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known as tract #1 of the yearning land
 bounded by lands of John B. Hyde, Frank Austin
 and others, containing 61 acres, more or less, and
 being the same tract of land conveyed to me by
 W. Glenn by deed dated December 14, 1906, and
 recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County
 in Vol. 000 page 505

Also all that other lot of land in Austin Township, County and State
 aforesaid, on Gilders Creek, containing 57 3/4 acres, more or less, and
 having the following Metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake
 3237 fm on branch, thence N. 39 1/2 E. 30.00 to Spanish oak, 3100m
 (down), stone Xmm on old run, thence with Gilders Creek as the line
 to a W. O. 3232 fm instead of Black Jack 3234 fm (down), thence
 S. 24 1/2 W. 51.55 to R. O. 3230m, thence with the branch as the line
 32.00 to the beginning corner, being the same tract of land conveyed
